



## WORLD WETLAND NETWORK

### SUB-REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVE AGREEMENT

The World Wetland Network (WWN) is an initiative of NGOs and community groups that work together through an international network, to raise the profile of our work in conserving wetlands, and to provide support for our members' work on the ground.

WWN has the specific objectives to:

- a) Facilitate and coordinate the involvement of wetland NGOs at every Ramsar COP, particularly through the international NGO meeting.
- b) Raise the profile of wetland NGOs and their role in the local delivery of international wetland conservation agreements.
- c) Create an international platform to share knowledge and spread messages about the best practices for wetland conservation and wise use.
- d) Take positive action to support good wetland management, and offer support to local NGOs in their work to protect internationally important wetlands.

WWN relies heavily on its regional and local members. The Regional Representatives act at a continental scale, and form the WWN Committee. Their role is to help plan and identify the priorities of the WWN, communicate to the members in their region, and to report back on progress. We also have a network of 'sub regional' representatives (SRR) whose role is to maintain contact with members at a country or sub-regional scale. These sub-regional representatives are crucial to getting messages out to WWN members and potential members, as well as to help publicise our projects. They will feed back to the Regional Reps, and receive support and guidance from the WWN Committee itself. The SRR role is to:

- Maintain contact with the Regional Reps of the WWN, and keep up to date with its activities, attending meetings via skype or face-to-face as appropriate.
- Support the implementation of the WWN strategic plan, with the coordination of the regional rep and the WWN committee.
- Communicate messages and campaigns to members and partners within their sub-region and its countries (including the Wetland Globes)
- Feed back news and updates from the sub region to the Regional Representative and the WWN Committee.
- Help develop projects with the WWN Committee and local representatives, including developing bids, offering support to members, and helping to report back to funders and partners.

## AGREEMENT OF WWN SUB-REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVE

As a sub-regional representative of the WWN I/we agree to:

- Work to the overall objectives of WWN as bulleted above.
- Ensure the WWN logo and appropriate branding will appear on all relevant communications.
- Provide accurate information to the WWN Regional Representative.
- Support other members of the network who may approach us for advice from time-to-time.
- Maintain regular contact with the regional and global WWN representatives.
- Take part in regional WWN conferences / skype calls / events wherever possible.
- In no way to use the network for any political or personal gain.
